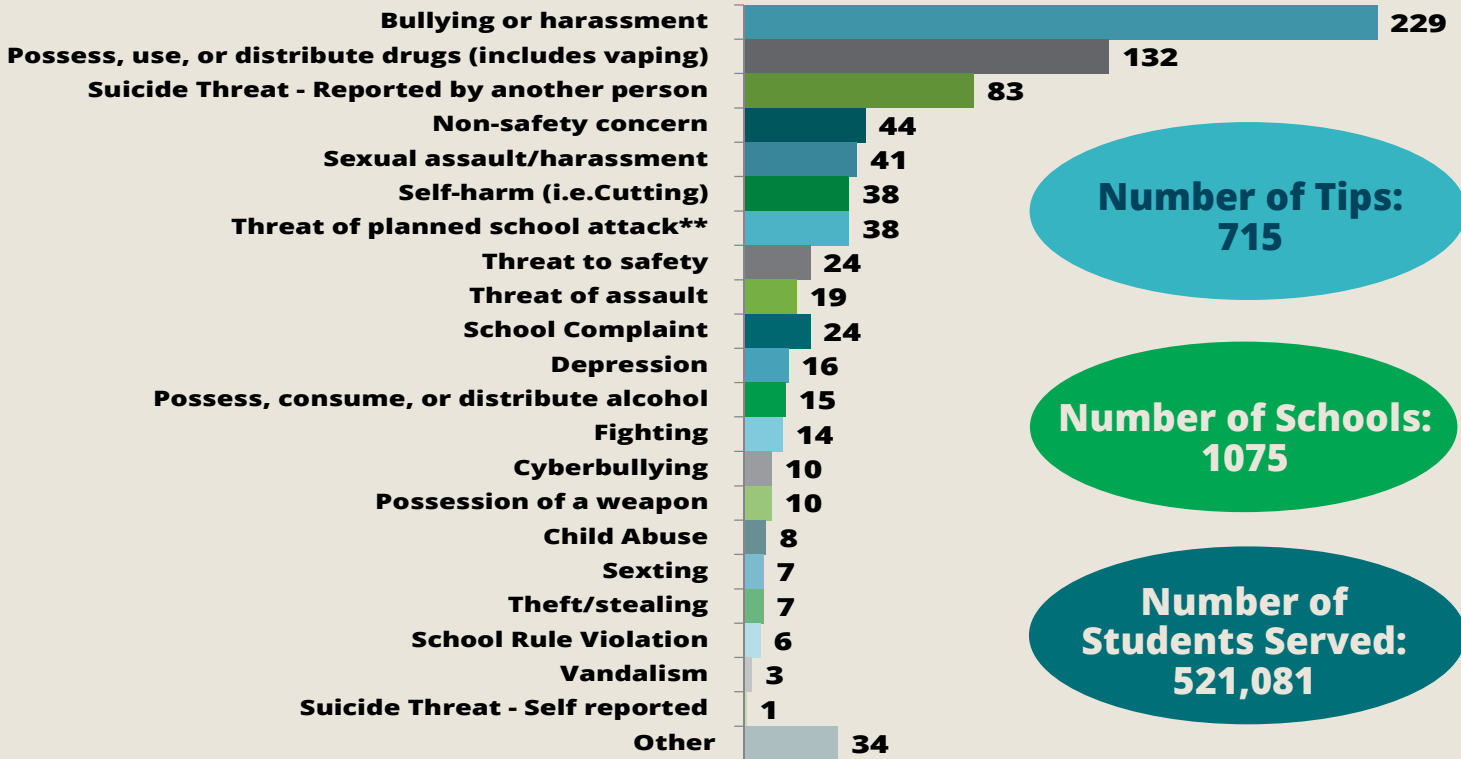
Program Highlights:

- Oregon hosted the first National School Safety Tip Line Summit in June 2018 with representatives from 21 states and Canada in attendance •

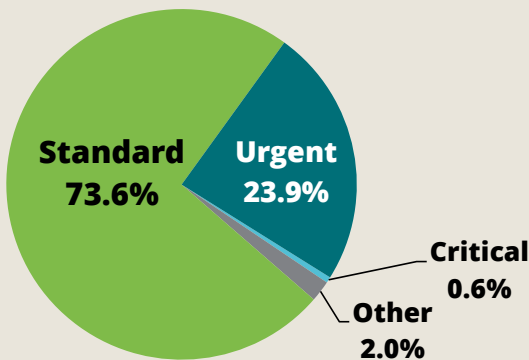
Executive Summary Highlights for this quarter:

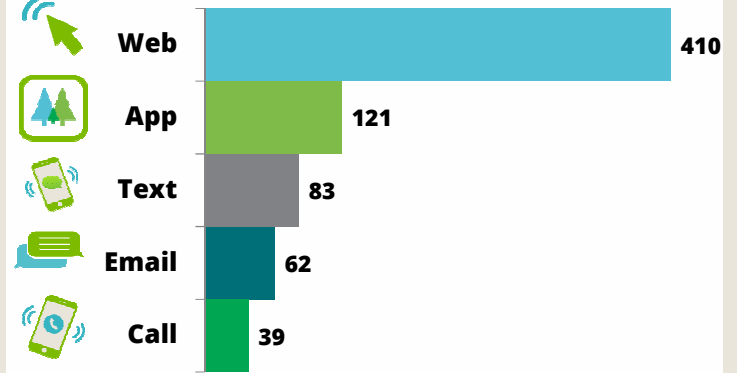
Incident Types*

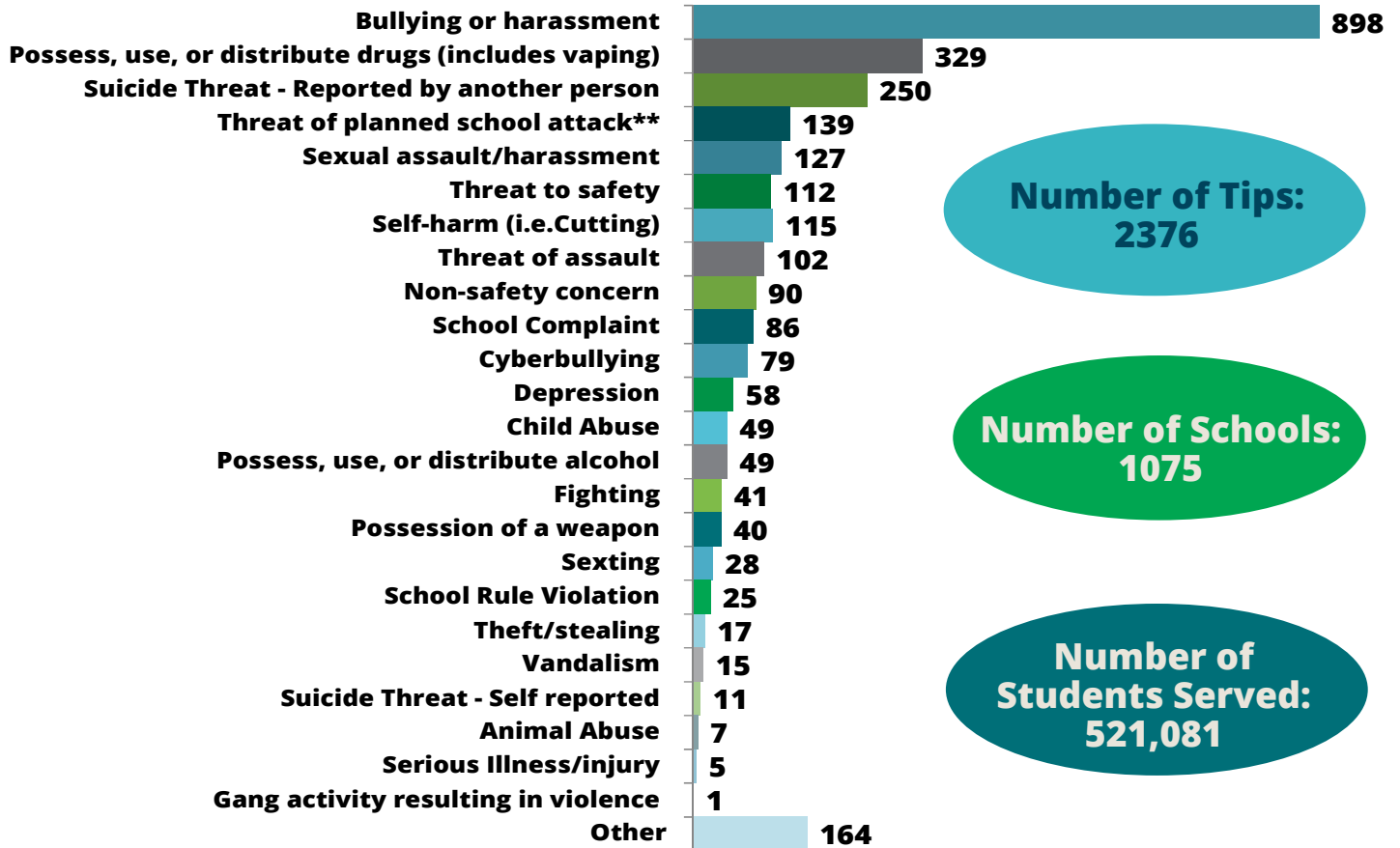

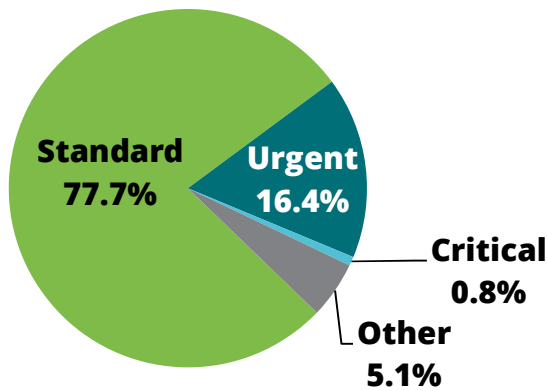

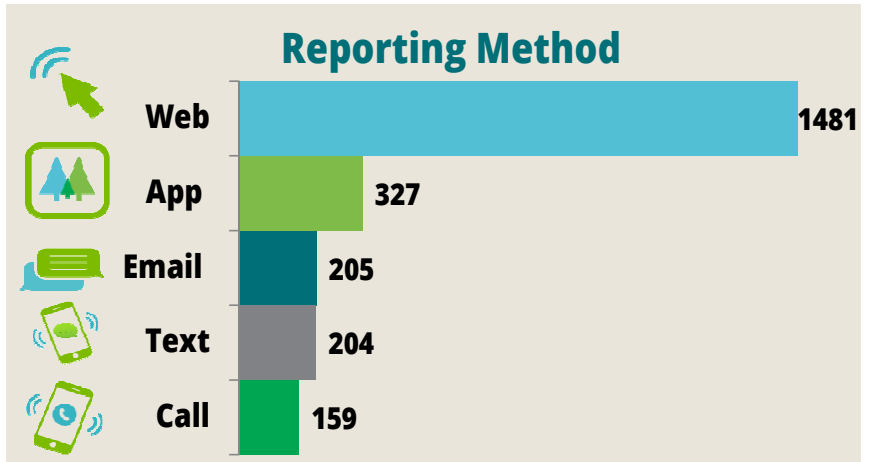
