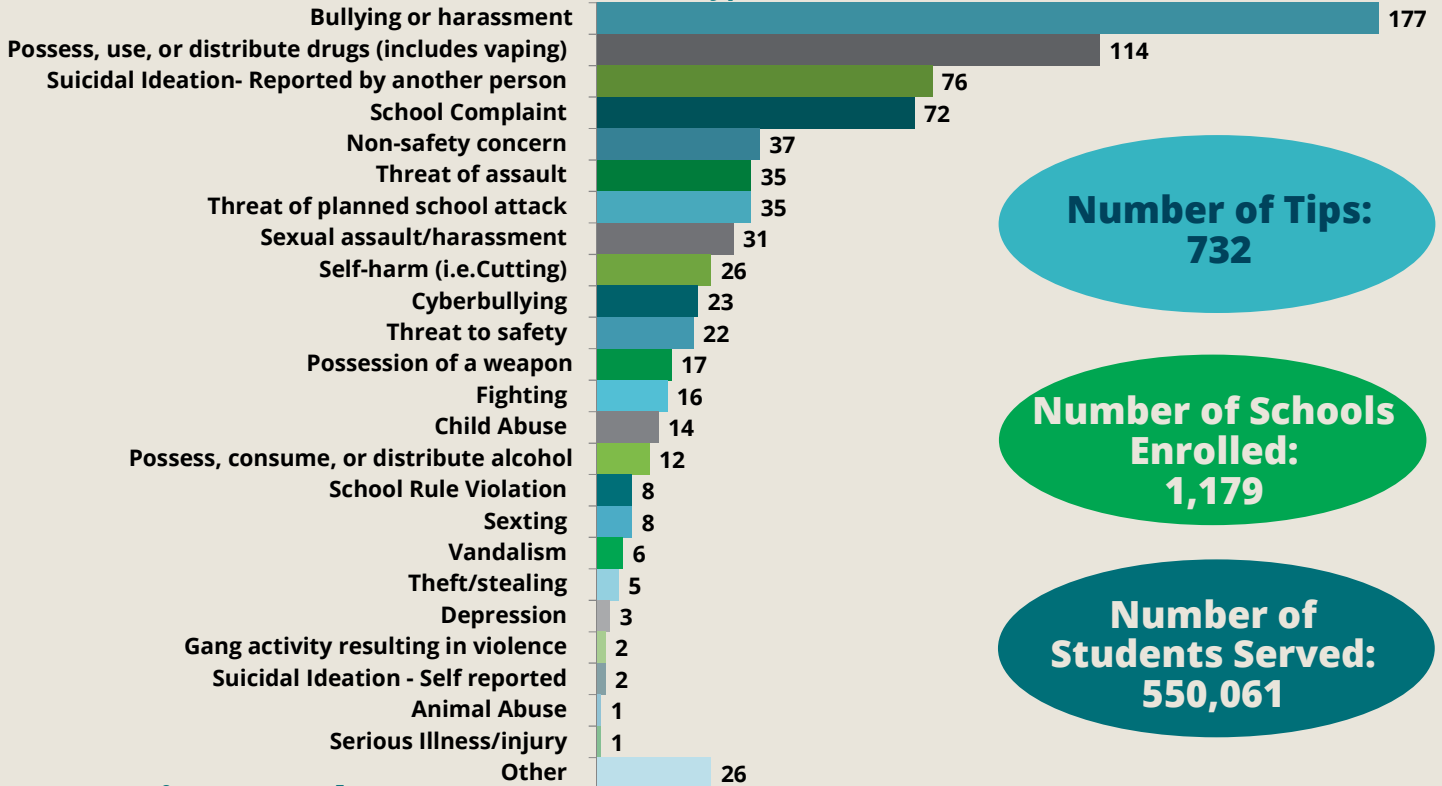

Executive Summary Highlights for this quarter:

• January 31, 2020 marked the three year anniversary of SafeOregon and KOIN 6 produced a segment on the supports provided for youth mental health through use of the tip line. • RTI International, funded through a National Institute of Justice grant, released their national research findings on the positive impact of tip lines and continue their work with SafeOregon. • NBC News published an article on the lifesaving nature of SafeOregon and the valuable results of tip lines regarding the youth mental health crisis. • SafeOregon continues to collaborate with the Oregon Task Force on School Safety's School Safety and Prevention System to promote the tip line and provide additional services to students.

Incident Types*

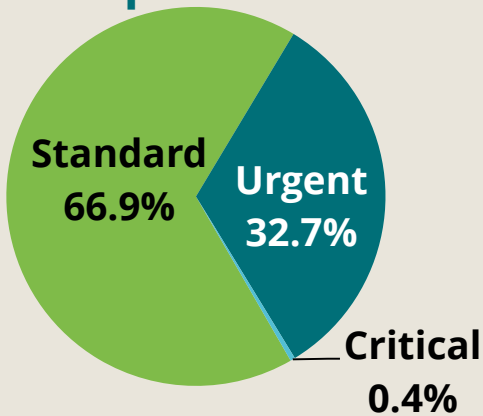

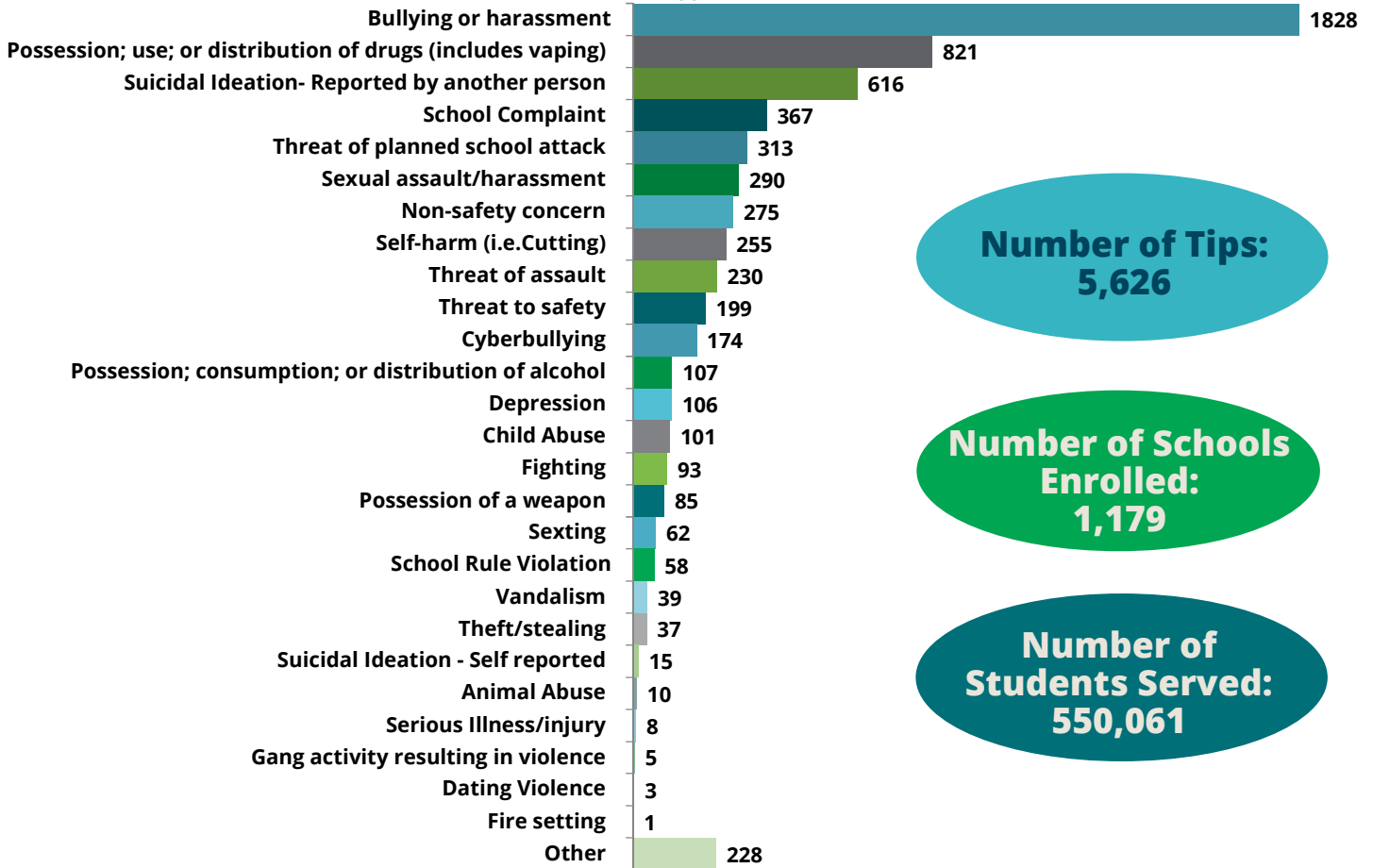

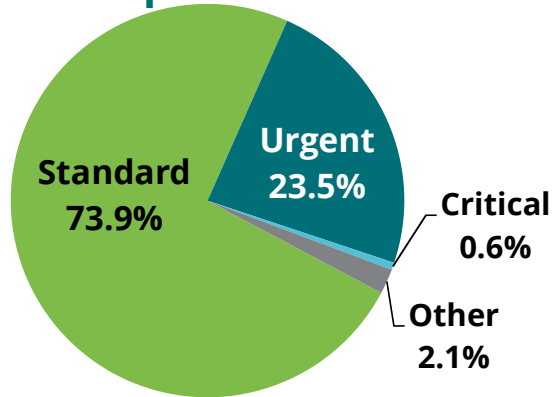
